### **New signs to adorn Mifflin Township's unincorporated area**

Mifflin Township's new gateway street signs have been approved by the Franklin County Engineers Office and will be springing up in the next few weeks. The 40-inch by 20-inch robust blue signs made of 49 percent recycled aluminum will showcase Mifflin Township.

"Gateway signs will visually define the neighborhood and increase resident pride," according to the [Clinton-Mifflin Land Use Plan](#) by the Franklin County Economic Development and Planning Department.

Pending approval of the Ohio Utilities Protection Service, Franklin County workers will erect five new signs at the intersections of Stelzer and Codet roads; Stelzer and Johnstown roads; Cassady and Drake roads; Agler Road westbound near the Bridgeview Golf Course; and Agler Road westbound before Interstate 270.

The sign project was a joint effort by the Franklin County Engineers Office and Franklin County Development Department in conjunction with the Mifflin Township Trustees.

"It is important for motorists and residents to know who is responsible for fire and police service," said Richard Angelou, Mifflin Township Trustee. "We also like to show off our township pride."

[Mifflin Township](#) has a population of 35,710 making it the second most populated township in the Columbus area and 17th largest of Ohio's 1,308 townships, and includes the city of Gahanna and unincorporated township area in northeast Franklin County. Mifflin Township has a fire department that services the city of Gahanna and unincorporated township areas, and police officers who protect residents in the unincorporated township area. Service department employees oversee cemeteries and maintain township roads. Three elected trustees comprise the Mifflin Township Board of Trustees which decides issues of township policy and is responsible for all expenditures of township funds.
